

**REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL**

**REPORT RELATING TO DETERMINATION NO. 1 OF 2002**

The Electoral Districts Boundaries Commission's Order of 17 November, 1998 becomes effective from 9 February, 2002 which is the date of the next election.

The Tribunal is therefore required to consider the effect of the new electoral districts to apply also from the date of the next election.

Eight of the districts have been renamed as follows:

- Coles to Morialta;
- Hanson to Ashford;
- Hart to Port Adelaide;
- Peake to West Torrens;
- Price to Cheltenham;
- Ross-Smith to Enfield;
- Spence to Croydon; and
- Gordon to Mount Gambier.

Additionally the reduction in the size of Hammond has resulted in the placement in a different category.

Changes in size to a number of other districts have not been sufficiently significant to justify altering their category.

An election has been called to be held on 9 February, 2002 and this Determination reflects the above changes to take effect from 9 February, 2002.

This Determination does not change the monetary amounts which will be reviewed later in the year.
