DETERMINATION AND REPORT OF THE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL
OVERSEAS ACCOMMODATION AND DAILY ALLOWANCE FOR THE CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE
SUPREME COURT – TRAVEL TO PAPUA NEW GUINEA IN SEPTEMBER 2016

A. REPORT

1. The Remuneration Tribunal (“the Tribunal”) has received a request from the Courts Administration Authority (“CAA”) for a Determination in relation to the payment of overseas travelling allowances to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court for the purposes of business related travel to Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea. The travel is scheduled for September 2016.
2. The Tribunal’s Determination 6 of 2015¹ provides for the payment of travelling and accommodation allowances to members of the Judiciary. This Determination is silent on the matter of travelling and accommodation allowances for overseas journeys, therefore, the Tribunal has decided to make a Determination accordingly.

B. DETERMINATION

1. For the purpose of business related travel to Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea, undertaken by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of South Australia in September 2016, the Chief Justice shall be entitled to the accommodation and daily allowance provisions as prescribed by the Commonwealth Remuneration Tribunal’s Determination 7 of 2016, Official Travel by Office Holders.
2. All other conditions of Determination No. 6 of 2015, as amended from time to time, will continue to apply.

This determination will come into operation from 1 September 2016
